DES MOINES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

January 16, 2024

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, January 16, 2024, with Chair Tom Broeker, Vice-Chair Jim Cary, and Member Shane McCampbell present. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Items 5D & 5E were removed from the agenda. Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meeting with Department Heads: County Auditor Sara Doty stated her office is busy wrapping up the end of the year. She is working on preparing for the upcoming Primary Election in June, making sure the office is stocked up on all the necessary supplies. IT Director Colin Gerst reported his office is busy. They had an issue with the data center getting too warm, so he worked with the Maintenance Department to get a window air conditioner installed to keep the software at the temperature it needs. Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported the jail population is at 84. He attended an EMA meeting last week and they discussed new radio dispatch consoles being approved for DESCOM. Emergency Management Coordinator Shannon Prado was in attendance for the meeting. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated he wanted to give a shout out to his crew. They have been working a lot of hours in these cold temperatures to get snow cleaned up and keep things safe and cleaned up for the County. Local Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy. Safety Director Angela Vaughan stated she remains busy. MHASEI CDS Director Ken Hyndman gave us an update on the Mental Health Region. County Treasurer Janelle Nailey-Londquist reported her office is busy working on end of year processes. Land Use Administrator Zach James reported he has an agenda item. There are also a few subdivisions being processed and they are working on finalizing the end of the year. County Recorder Natalie Steffener stated her office is busy. County Engineer Brian Carter stated he wanted to give major credit to his crews who have been out in this snowstorm working long, cold days to get the roads cleaned. Jim Cary added that he would like to give the Secondary Roads crew a big thank you as well from the Board of Supervisors. The crews have put in 12-14 hour days and with some moments having been a complete whiteout. He wants to remind the public that the Secondary Roads Department does not clean out driveways or mailboxes. That is the homeowner's responsibility. There are several drifts where snow is over 10 foot with nowhere else for the snow to be pushed. He would also like to give credit to the Sheriff's Department for the calls they receive and helping the residents of Des Moines County. He wants to remind everyone that if you are stuck, do not leave your vehicle. Stay put and wait for help.

No Correspondence was received.

Approval of Resignation of Tama Township Clerk was presented. McCampbell made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of the Appointment of Tama Township Clerk was presented. Cary made a motion to approve Randy Meeker to Township Clerk and was seconded by McCampbell.

Personnel Actions – Sheriff – Theresa Tripp, Administrative Assistant, 1 Year Step Increase, \$49,761.40 yearly effective 1/22. McCampbell made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Cary motioned to approve the January 9th, 2024, regular meeting minutes and was seconded by McCampbell.

Leo Hallowell, 2018 S. 13th St. Burlington, spoke during public input. He asked the Board of Supervisors to please consider keeping the EMA budget with a part time employee wage, allowing them to hire a Volunteer Coordinator when Gina Hardin retires in March. He also wanted to give his thank you to the Board of Supervisors for considering the new Public Health Building.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 AM.

Notice is hereby given that the Henderson County Board is accepting bids for the following projects for the Henderson County Courthouse and Jail/Sheriff's Office located at the corners of 4th and Warren Streets, Oquawka, IL 61469:

Project 1: Courthouse Roof and Gutter Project – The proposed work consists of materials, labor, and equipment necessary to remove and replace the roof and gutters at the Henderson County Courthouse. Project completion deadline is August 1, 2024, unless otherwise approved in writing by the County.

Project 2: Courthouse and Sheriff Office Drop Ceiling Project – The proposed work consists of materials, labor, and equipment necessary to remove and replace drop ceiling tile, paint existing framework, and install flush mount, drop-in LED lighting. Project completion deadline is April 1, 2024 unless otherwise approved in writing by the County.

Project 3: Jail Plumbing Project – The proposed work consists of materials, labor, and equipment necessary to remove and replace lavatory fixtures, including stools, faucet assemblies, shower fixtures, and miscellaneous piping, fittings, and valves as needed. Project completion deadline is April 1, 2024 unless otherwise approved in writing by the County.

All projects can commence immediately after award of contract with scheduled start date approved by County.

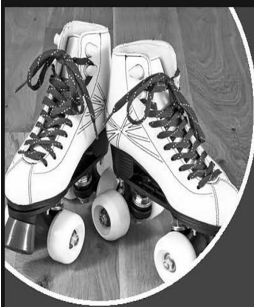
