Ridge View girls compete at BVU Indoor Meet Stowater wins high jump competition

The Ridge View girls' track and field squad traveled to Storm Lake on Friday, to participate in the Buena Vista University Indoor Meet. The Raptors

performance was highlighted by a first place showing by Madison Stowater in the high jump competition. Stowater won the event with a leap of 5 feet 3 inches, best in the field of 14 competitors.

Jaycie Vohs of Ridge View captured third place out of 20 competitors in the 1500 meter run, finishing

with a time of 5:29.77.

Madison Stowater won sixth place out of 23 competitors in the 400 meter

dash, turning in a time of 1:10.32. In the 200 meter dash, Ridge View's Jayley Endrulat placed 13th with a time of 33.18 seconds.

Addy Tesch captured sixth place out of 21 participants in the 800 meter run, with a time of 2:51.66. Alyssa Biede of Ridge View also competed, turning in a time of 3:00.71.

In the shot put contest, Ridge View juniors Sydney Blackmore and Liz Schimmer won eighth and ninth place out of 33 participants, with throws of 31 feet 6 inches and 31 feet 3 inches, respectively. Raptors junior Mazee Henningson also competed with a throw of 24 feet.






