1. Schedule of Fees. The fees for solid waste collection and disposal service, used or available are:

B. Commercial. Each multiple-family dwelling of five or more units, commercial, industrial, and institutional shall be charged per month according to container size:

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY
CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjusted invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be placed into effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

WATER DISCHARGE**

ALDI Inc. plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit Number 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities" for public construction in Newton, IA.

The stormwater discharge will be from site grading associated with the construction and development of a vacant lot, addressed 375 Iowa Speedway Drive, in Newton, IA. The site is located on the west side of Iowa Speedway Drive, approximately 950-ft south of 1st Ave East/Hwy 6. Soil disturbing activities will include the following: site clearing and grading, perimeter and other erosion and sediment controls, excavation, utility installation, commercial site construction, and the preparation for final planting and seeding. The project is located within the city limits of Newton, Iowa and more specifically within SW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, T-80-N, R-19-W, Jasper County, Iowa.

Runoff is currently sheet flowing off the vacant site following the natural grading contours. The proposed project will construct new storm sewer to serve the proposed development. The existing drainage conditions will be improved with the installation of the new storm drain. Runoff will be directed off-site through one point source. The site stormwater will ultimately drain to the Elk Creek.
