AUDIT REPORTS

Financial highlights:

STORM LAKE CSD

The District's revenues totaled \$48,564,912 for the year ended June 30, 2023, a 5.9% increase over the prior year. Expenses for the District operations for the year ended June 30, 2023 totaled \$43,267,100, a 9.6% increase over the prior year. The increase in revenues and expenses is due primarily to additional property tax, un-

restricted state grants and federal sources and negotiated salaries and benefits and construction/capital improvement projects.

Audit findings:

Cornwell, Frideres, Maher & Associates, P.L.C reported three findings related to the receipt and expenditure of taxpayer funds. They are found on pages 106 through 113 of the audit report. The findings address issues such as a lack of segregation of duties. Cornwell, Frideres, Maher & Associates, P.L.C provided the District with recommendations to address the findings.

The three findings discussed above are a repeat of Alta, Iowa.

T.P. Anderson & Company, P.C. on Jan. 18 released an audit report for the City of Alta, Iowa.

T.P. Anderson & Co., P.C. reported that the city's receipts totaled \$5,936,313 for the year ended June 30, 2023. The receipts included \$776,695 in property tax, \$650,176 in charges for service, \$1,351,667 in intergovernmental receipts and \$328,644 in local option sales tax.

Disbursements for the year

Disbursements for the year totaled \$4,972,693. The disbursements included \$325,357 in public safety, \$684,115 for culture and recreation, \$2,589,501 for capital projects, and \$666,591 for business-type activities.
